While out in the rain, for years my car and I have suffered from it cascading down the roof of my fixed head AUSTIN 7 RN saloon, curling

under the overhang at the front, sneakily finding its way past the rubber seal to run down the inside of the windscreen and dripping on the floor creating large puddles especially after heavy rain.

After 32 years of ownership I've now cured this by sticking a strip of 4mm D-shaped rubber along the underside of the overhang so the rain HAS to follow its new course and instead of dripping inside it now falls onto the bonnet!
